Idaho Falls is a small community (with a population of barely more than 50,000) located in the Snake River Valley in Southeast Idaho. Rich in history, culture and industry, the community is growing and expanding while holding to the traditions espoused by its founders and community leaders. In 2005, [Melaleuca Inc.](#) purchased a full-page running ad in the city's only daily newspaper, the Post Register, to be used as a forum for highlighting important businesses, charitable projects, community events and pertinent community issues.

For the two years since its beginning, the Community Page has been used to feature businesses native to Idaho Falls, such as Farr's Candy; upcoming events, such as the annual Rotary Duck Race; and charitable associations, including the local chapter of the Salvation Army.
